ADMISSIONS POLICY – for September 2018

HOWE GREEN HOUSE SCHOOL

This Policy also includes the Early Years Foundation Stage

Statement of Intent

The staff and governors of Howe Green House School believe that our school should provide a caring, positive, safe and stimulating environment, which promotes the intellectual, social, physical, and moral development of the individual child.

Valuing diversity and promoting equality.

Howe Green House welcomes children from all backgrounds between the ages of 2 and 11 irrespective of sex, gender reassignment, sexual orientation, disability, race, religion or belief.

We are a non-academically selective school and we pride ourselves on the progress of the broad ability range of the children in our care. For entry at Year 3 or above, assessments will be carried out as part of the entry procedure to provide us with information regarding ability at the point of school entry. These assessments also assist us to understand each child's particular strengths and areas that may require development and to ascertain if any needs can be met within the usual school provision. If a child is transferring to us from another school a reference will be sought and a copy of the previous year's report will be requested as part of the admission process.

Children may enter our school at any age as long as there are places available, though the majority enter at Nursery or Reception (2+ and 4+).

Registration forms are available, upon request, from the School Office and on the school website, and a Registration Fee is payable to begin the admission process.

Children are admitted to Reception in the September term. They must be four years of age by 1 September of their year of entry.

Places will be confirmed in the October of the year prior to entry, when an Acceptance Fee becomes payable. This Fee is only refundable when the child leaves the school at the end of Year 6, less any amounts outstanding on the final account. Parents whose children enter the school during the academic year will be required to pay the Acceptance Fee immediately, once a place is confirmed. If an offered and accepted place is subsequently not taken up, there will be a cancellation charge equal to one term's fees.

A full term's notice in writing is required (or a term's fees in lieu) before withdrawing a child from the school.

If no places are available, parents may place their child on the waiting list. Priority is given to parents who have other children already in the school or Acorns Nursery.

Parents are asked to sign the registration form agreeing to abide by the School's policies and procedures.

The procedures outlined below, for Acorns Nursery, should be read in conjunction with this policy

Acorns Nursery - Admissions

Procedure Statement

Acorns Nursery is the main feeder into Howe Green House School. It is our intention to make our setting accessible to children and families from all sections of the local community.

Registration forms are available to download from the website and upon request from the School Office. A twenty-five pound non-refundable fee is charged, payable on registration. Parents are asked to sign the registration form agreeing to abide by the Nursery's policies and procedures.

Children are admitted to the Nursery from their 2nd birthday, space permitting.

Our policy will take into account the following criteria:

- Priority for entry to the nursery will be given to children with siblings already attending Howe Green House School.
- Priority will be given to children who have allocated places into Reception.
- Priority will be given to children who are on the Reception waiting list.

Children attending Acorns Nursery will be given priority on the waiting list for entry into the main school.

Fees for pre-booked sessions are payable in advance on a block half termly basis. The school will confirm in writing the availability of the requested sessions in the term before the child is due to start nursery.

Prior to a child's attendance at the nursery the parent/carer must complete the registration form and entry form

We are flexible about attendance patterns to accommodate the needs of individual children and families wherever possible.
